First Responders

- No further cuts to Calgary Police Service budget
- Establishment of a Calgary Fire Commission
- Enshrine NFPA Standards and 24 hour shifts

Regulatory Budget

- In order to keep the level of regulation under control, advocating for a regulatory budget, where for every new regulation created, two are eliminated

Communication

- Continue the email response rate maintained through my campaign of 100%. Every question deserves an answer.
- Commit one day of the work week purely to community outreach to encourage communication from residents within the ward
- Continue to record and produce my podcast “Your Neck of the Woods” as a way to inform ward residents of their local government
- Committing to plain language policy and project announcements. No high-level technical speak when it’s not necessary.
 - Commit to monthly meetings with all community associations within the ward to help ensure the needs of all residents are being met.

Infrastructure

- Revamp snow and ice control to include the removal of windrows
- Creation of a suburban infrastructure Revitalization Fund

Mental Health

- Create an online portal where someone seeking mental health care for themselves or loved ones can search resources based on cost, program availability, and symptoms
- Work with our provincial partners to improve access to mental health services for low-income Calgarians
- By taking these steps we can decrease the number of mental health crisis calls fielded by Calgary Police Service and improve outcomes



Urban Sprawl

- A 20% increase in permit fees for projects \$2,000 and below
- An 8% increase on permit fees for projects \$20,000 and above

Term Limits

- Amend the Municipal Act to limit councillors and the mayor to two terms

Affordability and Accessibility

- Continue and complete the retiring of the first generation U2 transit cars
- Enshrine the Rick Hansen Foundation standards for the Built Environment into the building code for commercial and government buildings to allow all Calgarians access to workplaces
- Sign language interpreters for city council meetings to assist hearing impaired Calgarians
- Encourage affordable housing by allowing developers to put their name on these projects
